Coverage overview – Incoming Sweden

Illness, injury or accident	€ 30 000 maximum per claim
Acute dental treatment in case of acute accident	
Journey, medicine, rehabilitation in connection with medical treatment	
Journey home/home transportation	
Repatriation of deceased person	
Burial at the place of stay	€ 3 000 maximum per claim

Who can take out the insurance?

The insurance can be taken out by foreign citizens, under the age of 70 years, who are to temporarily visit Sweden or other country within the Nordic Region.

Important notice:

- The insurance has to be taken before the arrival to Sweden or the Nordic Region.

Where is the insurance valid?

The insurance is valid in the Nordic region. The insurance is also valid for short trips to other countries within the Schengen area if the person insured has a valid Schengen visa issued by a Swedish embassy or other Swedish authority abroad.

When is the insurance valid?

The insurance is valid from the moment you arrive in the Nordic Region and valid until you leave the Nordic Region for your homeward journey.

Important notice:

- The insurance is not valid in the Schengen area if the visit occurs before arrival to the Nordic region or after the homeward journey from the Nordic region has begun.

Deductible

The policy is valid with a deductible of € 100 per each claim.

If you become ill, injured or are involved in an accident

What will you be compensated for?

The insurance compensates for necessary and reasonable costs for acute medical treatment, hospital treatment and medicines as well as travel expenses in connection with the medical visits.

The insurance will compensate medical costs for acute illness, injury or accident for a period of 60 days counting from your first visit to a

doctor. The insurance covers necessary and reasonable costs if a medical complication occurs during pregnancy, but not if the cost arise after the 28th week of pregnancy.

Dental treatment

What will you be compensated for?

The insurance will compensate dental treatment costs caused by an accident as well as travel expenses in connection with dental treatment. The policy will compensate dental treatment costs, caused by an accident, for a period of 60 days counting from your first visit to the dentist.

Important notice:

- The insurance needs to be taken out and paid for before arriving to Sweden or the Nordic region.
